Employee Health

What is the Employee & Family Health Clinic?

A clinic designed to screen, diagnose, and treat minor illnesses or injuries that require prompt attention but are not of such seriousness to require a visit to an emergency room.

Who is Eligible to Use the Employee & Family Health Clinic and Program?

- All currently employed Full-Time and Part-time Macon County employees, whether or not they participate in the county's health insurance benefit.
- Spouses on employee's insurance
- Dependents on employee's insurance
- Retired County employees on county insurance plan

What Does the Clinic Offer?

- No co-pay for sick visits to clinic
- This clinic can treat sprains, strains and rashes, colds, sore throats, allergies, insect bites, sinus issues, upset stomachs, and much more!
- Lab testing with fast results for illnesses such as flu, strep throat, mononucleosis, urinary tract infections and other labs as ordered by the provider during your visit.
- If your visit requires a prescription, it can be sent to the pharmacy of your choice.
- The clinic offers Over-the-Counter medications at a reduced cost (\$1 \$3).
- Employees are **allowed 1 hour paid leave** to visit the clinic for services.

** Abnormal values found during Employee Health sick visits may need to be managed by a Primary Care Provider.

** Problems lasting greater than 6 months are generally considered chronic and should be managed by a Primary Care Provider

** If you do not have a Primary Care Provider, Macon County Public Health may be able to help. Fill out an application to see if we are a good fit for you! Applications can be picked up at MCPH or printed from your computer at: <u>https://maconnc.org/Integrated.html</u>

Laboratory Services

If your doctor writes an order for blood work, bring the order to the Macon County Public Health laboratory (or have them fax it to us). Your blood work is usually back within 24 – 48 hours with results faxed to the ordering physician. There is no charge for lab work completed at MCPH.

Example of what to say when calling for lab work ordered by an outside provider: "Hi, I need an appointment for labs and I am a county employee." This ensures that clerical knows you are calling for FREE labs.
