

MACON COUNTY PLANNING BOARD MINUTES

October 26th, 2004

A meeting of the Macon County Planning Board was held on October 26th, 2004 at the Macon County Environmental Resource Center. The meeting was called to order at 12:00 pm.

CALL TO ORDER:

Planning Board members present were Ronnie Beale, Lamar Sprinkle, Larry Stenger, Susan Ervin, Alan Marsh, Commissioner Mark West and County Planning Director Stacy Guffey.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Susan Ervin made the motion to adopt the minutes from the October 12th meeting. Larry Stenger seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

PUBLIC SESSION:

During public session, no one chose to speak.

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS:

Chairman Beale talked about the High Impact Moratorium. He expressed his support for the commission decision regardless of whether the chose to invoke 3 months or 6 months.

NEW BUSINESS:

Guffey gave the board a brief summary of the changes in the second draft of the High Impact Ordinance. Minor changes were made to the wording of definitions. The consensus of the board was that the next meeting should focus on the "easiest" uses. Those uses include Airfields/Airstrips, Helicopter Sightseeing Operations, Radioactive/Hazardous Waste Facilities, Motor Sport Facilities and Slaughtering and Processing Plants.

Chairman Beale stated the need to have all Planning Board members present at meetings. He said he would call the absent members.

The meeting adjourned at 3:30 p.m.
