GENERAL DEFINITION OF WORK

Reviews detailed estimates of housing projects, and inventories tools and materials to be used. Performs energy work processes and housing rehabilitation repairs and modifications, ensuring compliance with Macon County and grant rules and regulations, including general air sealing, such as caulking, weatherstripping, sealing ducts, tightening windows and doors; installing insulation in attics, kneel walls, sidewalls, and around water heaters, furnace ducts and water pipes; and making repairs involving installation of various materials such as drywall, lumber and glass. Maintains accurate inventory of all materials used on job sites, providing daily accounting to supervisor. Maintains accurate inventory of all tools and machinery assigned to Housing Crew, reporting discrepancies to supervisor. Performs related duties as assigned.
