# Macon County Planning Board Minutes

# October 20, 2011

<u>Call to Order:</u> Chairman Lewis Penland called the meeting to order at 5:01 pm. in the Macon County Health Department

## **Liaison Reports:**

Bob Kuppers informed the board that the Commission is currently discussing term limits. The Planning Board is involved in this on-going discussion. Not every board is being looked at by the commission with respect to term limits, according to Kuppers. There is no consensus on the board at this time, other than a further investigation of Macon County Boards which are appointed by the Commission is warranted. The Commission plans to continue this discussion into November.

Penland informed the board that Andrea Leslie, the western watershed planner for DENR will be making a presentation at the next meeting of the board.

#### **Review of Macon County Subdivision Ordinance**

Roland provided members of the board with individual folders. #### **General Statute**

 153A-330 Subdivision Regulation- 153A-336 Appeals of decisions on subdivision plats

The Board decided to begin discussions in November with vested rights, as many members throughout the community have raised issues dealing with this topic. Roland will work to find out any options the county might have regarding vested rights prior to the next meeting.

**Public Comment:** Christina Oliver relayed her concerns about the lot she had purchased in the Diamond Falls Subdivision. Oliver's complaint focused primarily on promises made to her by the developer that had not yet been fulfilled. Oliver expressed further concerns regarding emergency vehicle access to her lot which is located in Phase 2 of the aforementioned subdivision.

Roland commented that the county currently holds an active bond for Phase 2 of Diamond Falls Subdivision. Furthermore, Roland reminded the board that promises made by the developer and minimum standards as set forth in the Macon County Subdivision Ordinance are two different things, the first of which Macon County has no control over..
